

How to use Hebrew Keyboard on Chromebook

Changing Keyboard Language

1. Press **Ctrl + Shift + Spacebar** at the same time
2. The language will cycle between English (US) and Hebrew (IL) each time you press this key combination
3. To get back to your default language, press **Ctrl + Space**

Niqud for Chromebook Key Combos - AltGr = Alt key right of the spacebar

When you are in Hebrew on a Chromebook (Ctrl + Spacebar to switch back and forth), position the cursor after the letter under/over which you wish to insert a vowel. Hold the AltGr (again, the Alt Key to the right of the spacebar) plus the following keys to insert niqud.

AltGr + J (ח)	קריח
AltGr + M (צ)	חריצ
AltGr + S (ד)	שנד (also the dot for קרוש)
AltGr + A (ש)	אוש
AltGr + \	ץובק
AltGr + W	dot for ׳ניש׳

AltGr + Q	dot for נוש
AltGr + 7	נתמ
AltGr + -	פקמ
AltGr + '/"	י"שר - a/k/a tzupchik מישרג
AltGr + `/~	שרג - ר
AltGr + ;	Bottom of the line quote mark - „
AltGr +	Quote mark proper direction - "
AltGr + 4	₪ New Israeli Shekel NIS
AltGr +]	ר - mark הפר
